Therea pizza on the table.

There six (6) hippos in the pool.

There a frog in the grass.

There ten (10) children in the room.

There an apple in the bag.

There monster in the tree.

There four (4) frogs in the grass.

There a hippo next to me.

Vocabulary:

cat = Katze (cats = Katzen)

hippo = Nilpferd (hippos)

in the pool = im Pool

in the grass = im Gras

children = Kinder

in the room = im Raum

in the bag = in der Tasche

in the tree = im Baum

next to me = neben mir

frog = Frosch (frogs MZ)
